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MONTHLY REPORT- JULY 2026

Executive summary.

This report highlights key achievements and progress made by S.A.C in the month of July 2026 across our core program area: Education, Health, Sports, and child wellness.

Our long-term investment in education continues to bear fruits. Students we started with in baby class are now at campus pursuing professional courses.

On 4th / July / 2026, we flagged off 4 students joining university in courses including Business Administration, Education, Nursing and public Administration.

Additionally, previous university beneficiaries are now undertaking internship in different organisations.

To improve access to medical care, we signed an MOU with St. Francis Hospital Nyenga which is near our project. This partnership provides faster treatment, reduced costs, and priority care for our children and staff. This month, beneficiaries included the school principal who was treated for blood pressure and infection and she is now stable, plus 3 children treated for common illnesses. No child missed treatment due to lack of funds.

In talent development, we achieved a major milestone. Our football Academy is now officially registered and affiliated under the Uganda Youth Football Association (UYFA). This gives our talented boys and girls a structured pathway to compete in national youth league. Current priority needs include; sports kits, equipment's and transport to enable participation in league games.

We updated so far 20 profiles for individual child. Each profile now captures the child's background, their journey with us, current status and dreams. This exercise is critical as it bridges the distance and show the real impact of your support. This new month, we are to profile more.

In conclusion, July 2026 has been a month of milestone. From flagging off students to university, to signing of MoU, registering a sports academy, and strengthening sponsor relationships, we are seeing the results of consistent and holistic support.

We remain committed to our vision and support the vulnerable children from baby class to a professional qualification.

Sejjengo Mubinu at Buganda Royal Institute pursuing a certificate in building and construction which will led him to a diploma in civil engineering. Now on internship



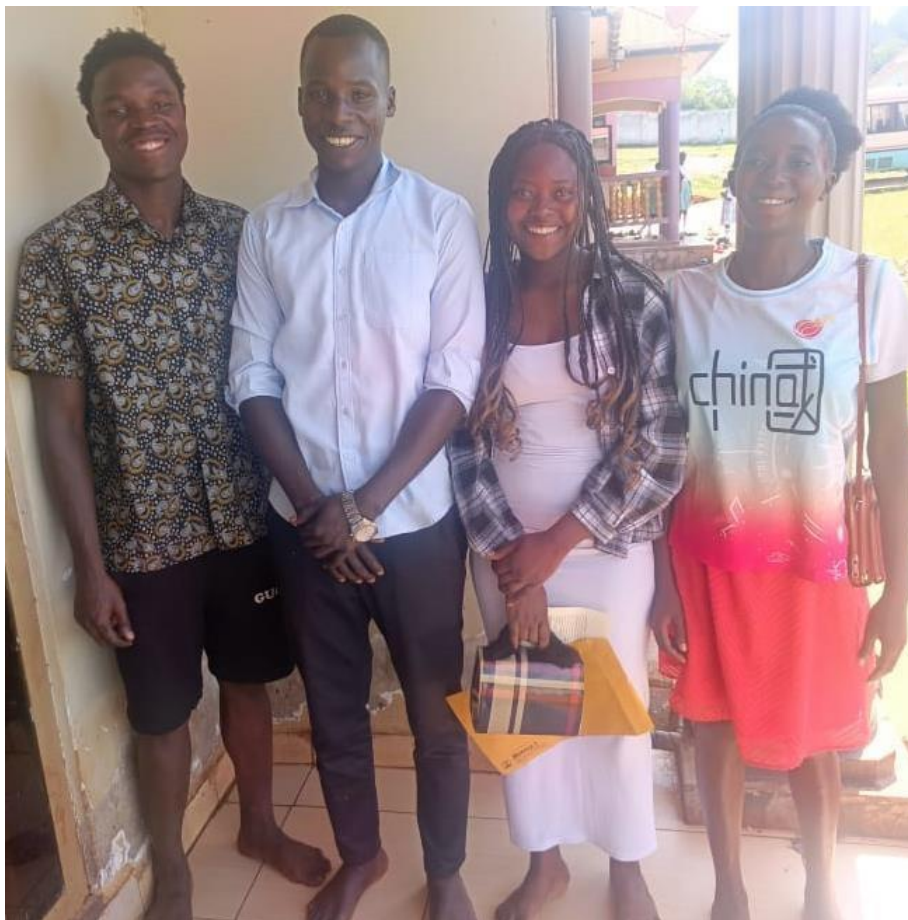
Aloro Emmanuel who is now at his final year at Mutesa 1 Royal University doing a diploma in Information Technology. On his final internship

B. HEALTH

This month, the organisation signed a Memorandum of Understanding with St. Francis Hospital Nyenga, a hospital located near our project area.

The purpose of the MoU is to ensure timely, affordable, and quality medical treatment for all vulnerable children under our care and staff.

Some of the key benefits of the partnership include;

1. Faster access to treatment. Our children have been referred and treated immediately without delays.
2. The hospital has agreed to offer subsidised rates for consultations, lab tests and medication.
3. Our children like Junior Williams and Abura Marvin have already received priority medical attention as registered beneficiaries of the organisation.
4. The hospital is also to help us with health talks and outreaches for children and caregivers.

The partnership is already reducing the burden of medical expenses on the organisation and ensuring no child misses treatment due to lack of funds.

We are to continue utilising the MoU to ensure all emergency and routine cases are handled promptly. We also anticipate to conduct health education sessions on hygiene, nutrition and NCDs for children and parents.

C. SPORTS AND TALENT DEVELOPMENT

We are excited to report a major achievement in talent development. The organisation has officially registered a Football Academy.

We are now duly registered and affiliated under the Uganda Youth Football Association (UYFA). This makes us a recognised body for youth football development in Uganda.

This success means a lot to us for example;

1. Our academy can now participate in all UYFA sanctioned leagues and tournaments
2. Vulnerable children with football talent now have a structured pathway from community level to national level.
3. Being under UYFA ensures our academy follows national guidelines on child safeguarding and coaching standards.
4. The academy gives our organisation more visibility and a new platform to identify and support talented children.

This registration is a big step in using sports as a tool for education, discipline, and keeping children away from harmful activities.
